Materials Needed – For the Table

- ✓ A Table and Tablecloth
- ✓ Seder Plate
 if you don't have one, make your own. All you need is a plate.
- √ Chairs 1 per guest
- √ Pillows / Cushions 1 per guest
- \checkmark Candles 2
- ✓ Kiddush Cup / Wine Glass 1 per guest

 Don't forget Elijah
- ✓ Plate / Basket for Matzah
- √ Matzah Cover 3 Compartments
- √ Afikomen Bag
- ✓ Decorations

Flowers, Original Art, Costumes, Wall Hangings, etc., Be Creative

Materials Needed - Food

- ✓ Matzah
- √ Wine / Grape Juice
- √ Karpas Leafy Green Vegetable

Parsely, Celery, Potato

- √ Salt Water
- ✓ Maror Bitter Herb
 Horseradish, Romaine Lettuce, Endive
- √ Charoset



15 Steps of the Seder

*Kadesh Recite the Kiddush

*Urchatz Wash hands without a blessing

*Karpas Eat parsley or potato dipped in salt water

*Yachatz Break the middle Matza. Hide the bigger piece for the Afikoman.

15 Steps of the Seder

*Magid Tell the story of Israel's deliverance from Egyptian bondage.

- Ha Lachma Anya "This is the Bread of Affliction"
- *Mah Nishtana The Four Questions
- *Avadim Hayinu "We Were Slaves"; Tell the story of freedom using the Haggadah or in your own words.
- Four Children

- Arami Oved Avi "My ancestor was a wandering Aramean"
- Ten Plagues
- Dayeinu
- *Explain Pesach, Matzah, Maror
- In Every Generation...
- *Second Cup

* Asterix means it is required

15 Steps of the Seder

*Rochtza Wash hands with a blessing

*Motzi Recite blessing over bread

*Matza Recite blessing over Matzah

*Maror Recite blessing and eat a bitter herb

*Korech Combine Matza, Maror and Haroset and eat them together

*Shulchan Orech Partake of the festival meal

15 Steps of the Seder

*Tzafun Conclude the meal by eating the Afikoman.

*Barech Say grace after the meal.

- *Third cup of wine
- Open the door for Elijah; Sing Eliyahu HaNavi

Recite "Pour out your wrath"

Conducting the Seder 15 Steps of the Seder

*Hallel Recite the remainder of the Hallel.

- Songs of Praise
- *Fourth Cup

[*Second Night: Count the Omer]

*Nirtza End with Singing

- Echad Mi Yodea / Who Knows One?
- Chad Gadya / One Little Goat
- L'Shanah Haba'ah Birushalayim / Next Year in Jerusalem
